

OCR Level 1/2 Cambridge National in Child development

CONTENT OF COURSE:

This qualification gives students the opportunity to engage in a qualification where they will use their learning in practical, real-life situations. The course consists of three units:

R057: Health and well-being for child development.

In this unit students will learn about the importance of pre-conception health and reproduction, antenatal care and preparation for birth. They will also learn about care and the conditions in which a child can thrive.

R058: Create a safe environment and understand the nutritional needs of children from birth to five years.

In this unit students will learn how to create a safe environment for children from birth to five years in childcare setting. Students will research and choose equipment that is suitable and safe for use and will learn about children's nutrition and dietary needs.

R059: Understand the development of a child from one to five years.

In this unit students will learn the physical, intellectual and social development norms for children from one to five years. You'll understand the importance of creating plans and providing different play activities to support children in their development.

This course will inspire students to consider a career in early years, or related sectors. It will support progression to a more specialised level 3 vocational or academic course, such as early years, health and social care or psychology, or an apprenticeship.

ASSESSMENT AND EXAMINATION REQUIREMENTS:

R057 - this will be a 1 hour 15-minute examination that is worth 40% of the overall grade.

R058 – this is worth 30% of your overall grade and is a piece of written coursework

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
